JEFFREY UNIT CELEBRATES "50 YEARS"

When the doors opened to the Bill Jeffrey Memorial Boys Club back in 1957, board leaders Stanley Evans and W.D. Jeffrey had no idea that 50 years later the Club would still be a major part of the Fort Smith Boys & Girls Club organization. During the past 5 decades, the Club has served thousands of young people.

Originally built at the corner of Kinkead and North 50th Street, the Jeffrey Club was located on the campus of the UA Fort Smith (Westark College). Club board member Stanley Evans donated 50% of the construction cost and helped raise the balance of the funds through the help of W.D. Jeffrey. The Club was named after Jeffrey's son "Bill", who was killed in an automobile accident in 1955 at the age of 20. At the time, Bill Jeffrey was a student to the University of Arkansas in Fayetteville.

In 1965, a public fundraising campaign was held to build a gymnasium that could be used by both the Club and the College. Previous to 1965, the College used the Wheeler Boys Club gym for its home basketball games.

By 1978, growth of the College and the Club created overcrowding at the Jeffrey Club and gym facility. College and Club leaders worked together to find a place to relocate the Jeffrey unit. The Club was moved to 4905 North "O" Street and became the site of the administrative office for the organization.

"I remember back in the late 1970's when Coach Gayle Kaundart would get very

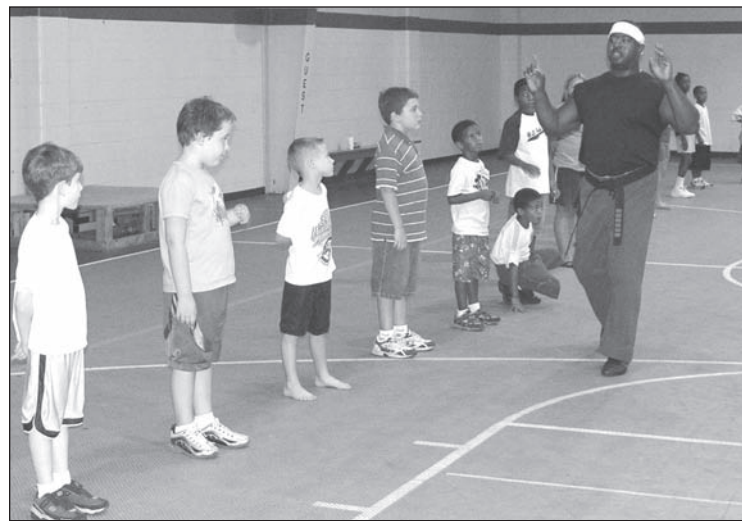
CLUB MEMBERS LEARN KEYS TO FITNESS

Maintaining a healthy lifestyle is something that is important for Club members to learn at an early age. Two programs (Triple Play and Karate) are being offered at the Fort Smith Boys & Girls Club this fall that demonstrate how eating right, keeping fit and forming positive relationships add up to a healthy lifestyle.

Triple Play, sponsored by The Coca-Cola Company and Kraft Foods Inc., is a dynamic wellness program that concentrates on three elements: Mind, Body and Soul. The goal of The Triple Play Program is to improve Club members' knowledge of healthy habits; increase the number of hours per day they participate in physical activities; and strengthen their ability to interact positively with others and engage in positive relationships.

Evans staff member Tim Higgins is the coordinator for the Triple Play program at the Fort Smith Boys & Girls Club. He uses after school games and activities to attract interest and participation by Club members.

Karate Classes are offered two nights per week at the Jeffrey and Evans units. Instructor Elton Hawkins is a certified "Fitness Specialist" who helps Club members build self-esteem, discipline and respect through learning the martial arts.

Population shifts in the Fort Smith community have impacted membership diversity at the Jeffrey unit during the past 15 years. The Club continues to serve nearby students from Kimmons Junior High along with Sutton and Sunnymeade Elementary schools.

Growth of the Jeffrey unit reached the "1,000 member" mark in 1985. That number was reduced with the opening of the new Goldtrap-Gardner unit in 1993. The all-time membership high at Jeffrey was in 1997, when it reached 1,218. However, that year the Stephens unit was closed for 10 months because of tornado damage.

W.D. Jeffrey died in July 1996 at the age of 92. He was the founder of Jeffrey Sand and Gravel company, and was involved with various civic projects throughout his career. His good friend Stanley Evans died in 1977. The foundation created by Mr. Jeffrey and Mr. Evans for the Fort Smith Boys & Girls Club is something that will be felt for many generations to come.

It's been a record membership year for the FSBGC Alumni & Friends Association. The 2007 membership roster has reached a record 531 members.

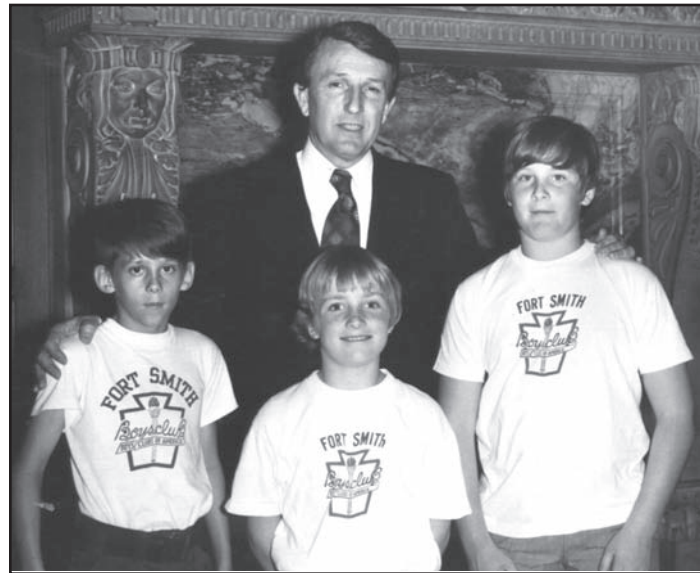

"LEAN ON ME" MENTORING SUPPORT BY ALUMNI

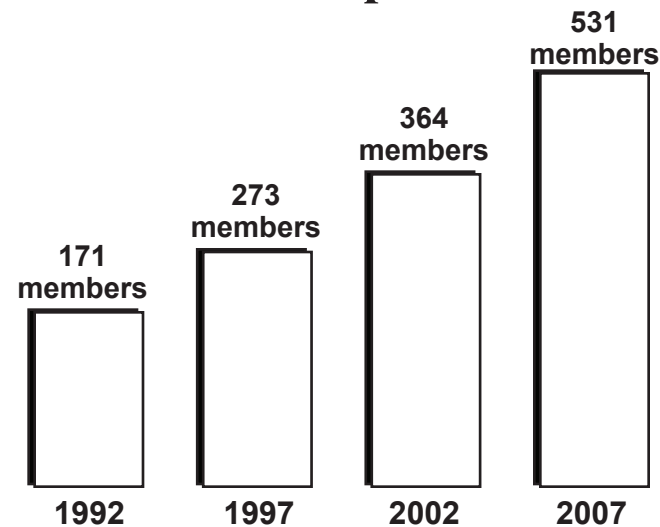
